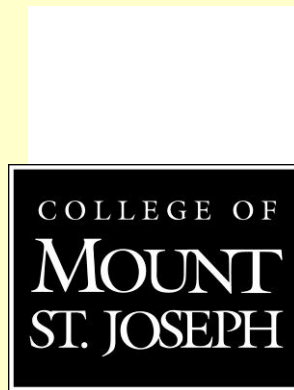

Focus: Proposals can be based on research or description of practices and should align with the conference theme.

Format: Proposals may be submitted for either of the following formats: Presentation - 50 or 75 minutes.
Round table discussion – 50 minutes

Proposal. Please submit the attached cover sheet with the proposal to include the following (1000 words or less).

1. Focus (topic and overview of content)
2. Purpose/Goals of session (including intended audience)
3. Source of content (research methods/data, reflective practice, or experience).
4. Explanation of how the session will be structured. Round table discussions should provide for guided interaction.

Session Title and Description: (100 words or less) to be posted in the conference schedule
